








Market Aerial

ATLANTA OVERVIEW

In March of 2017, the US Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that Atlanta had the highest rate of job growth of the 12 largest metros in the country between March of 2016 and March 2017. The manner in which this growth has taken place validates the overall health and vibrancy of the economy. For example, the overall increase was not artificially supported by significant growth in one major industry - other than the Information, Education, and Financial sectors, Atlanta experienced growth in excess of national rates in all major industry sectors that are present within the city. Similarly, this growth was not merely a one-time occurrence – Atlanta has now recorded yearover-year employment gains each month for over the last six years, demonstrating sustainable, established growth. Furthermore, Atlanta has experienced year-over-year growth in excess of the national rate in every month since September 2012.

Low living and business cost continue to boost job and population growth in Atlanta. In recent decades, Atlanta has drawn some of the strongest in-migration in the country. Many employers have openly stated that moving all or a portion of their operations to Atlanta saved them millions, without having to sacrifice access to high-quality labor.

The presence of the well-connected Hartsfiel-Jackson International Airport helps seal the deal for potential residents and companies, including Mercedes-Benz an State Farm., which have recently relocated major operations to the metro. Atlanta's status as a transportation and logistics hub also helped attract Norfolk Southern.

Metro Atlanta is home to 26 Fortune 1000 companies and 221 of the nation's fastest growing private companies (Inc. 5000), metro Atlanta is a premier location for corporate headquarters and benefits from a diversified and growing economy.
